



# *One-Eyed Jacks*

## **BAD BEAT RULES**



**Poker room hours are 12 pm to 2 am Monday—Saturday!**

**To qualify as a “Bad Beat” both the winning and losing hands must:**

*Be the player’s best possible combination of five cards*

*Include both of the player’s hole cards. All four-of-a-kind’s must be a pocket pair.*

*Only Texas Hold’em can qualify for the Bad Beat.*

All jackpot payouts will be made in even \$1 increments. Odd amounts will be credited to the primary level and the reserve will revert to the new primary level.

All jackpot monies up to \$5000 will be paid in cash, any excess amount will be paid in check form.

To be eligible for payment a person must have met the minimum buy-in requirements, played at least one hand and have not received a missed blind button.

When a bad beat situation is announced there must be a minimum of five (5) active players at the table to qualify for a bad beat jackpot.

Prior to the distribution of Bad Beat monies, surveillance will review the recordings of the bad beat circumstances. Discussion of hands during the play by players may void a Bad Beat Jackpot.

Jackpot will be awarded when four 2’s or higher is beaten by a higher 4-of-a-kind or better.

### Distribution of monies:

45% of Jackpot to the Losing hand

35% of Jackpot to the Winning hand

20% of Jackpot to the Players at the table

*Players must have proper ID to receive payment*

A player with a bad beat may only win one jackpot per hand.

High hand jackpot money will not be paid out during a bad beat jackpot.
